Research and Analysis on Financial Markets: "Market Action" in economics, quantitative and technical analysis

In addition to the evolution of Technical Analysis, recent structural developments on financial markets, such as the increase of electronic exchanges and algorithm trading or the multiplication of traders on a widespread financial asset, are modifying what is called the "market action".

At the same time, empirical or theoretical researches over the past few years, such as market efficiency or random walk, are more and more challenging paradigms. New approaches are developed to better fit the markets.

The IFTA Conference 2008 will focus on "Market Action", i.e. the dynamic of order flows, measured by the price movements and the volumes of transactions of financial assets.

The aim of the conference is to open a dialogue between those different approaches such as economics, and quantitative and technical analyses. Sometimes, an admitted result in one field, by intuition or experience, often remains an open problem in another field. The different sessions have been chosen from such a scope.

Speakers from the academic side have been invited to present their latest works on markets: Carol Osler from Brandeis University, Jasmina Hasanhodzic from MIT and Christopher Neely from Federal Reserve of St Louis.

After theoretical sessions discussed by a panel, practitioners will present how they apply their market knowledge to trading. A special session will be dedicated to a "Market Review for 2009", where Economists will debate with Technicians.

The IFTA 2008 Conference in Paris will be a great opportunity to open Technical Analysis to other research fields, for a mutual recognition. We really look forward to welcoming you to Paris for this intense and enjoyable event.
